

PHRASAL VERBS.

BE

- **To be after:** To want, to try to gain, to chase.
- **To be against:** To oppose.
- **To be for :** To be in favour of (**Opp:** To be against).
- **To be in:** To be at one's house or office.
- **To be on:** To be shown (on TV, at the cinema, theatre).
- **To be out:** Not to be at one's house or office. (**Opp:** To be in)

BREAK

- **To break down:** To stop working.
- **To break into:** To enter by force.

BRING:

- **To bring out:** To publish.
- **To bring together:** To join.
- **To bring up:** To raise a child.

CALL:

- **To call back:** To return a phone call.
- **To call for:** To demand, To need.
- **To call off:** To cancel.

CARRY:

- **To carry on:** To continue with.

COME:

- **To come across:** To found / To meet by chance.
- **To come back:** To return to memory.
- **To come down:** To move to a lower level. (= land / **Opp:** To take off)

CUT:

- **To cut off:** To disconnected.

GET:

- **To get across:** To communicate ideas.
- **To get after:** To chase.
- **To get away:** To leave, to go on holidays.
- **To get into:** To enter.
- **To get off:** To descend.

- **To get on: To enter.**
- **To get on with / (To bet on well with): To be on good terms with.**
- **To get out of: To come out of a space.**
- **To get up: To move to a higher level, to rise from bed.**

GIVE:

- **To give up: To stop , to abandon.**

GO:

- **To go ahead: To continue.**
- **To go away: To leave.**
- **To go back: To return.**
- **To go off: To explode.**
- **To go on: To continue.**
- **To go with: To match.**

HOLD:

- **To hold on: To wait (esp on the phone).**

KEEP:

- **To keep off: To stay away from = To keep away from.**
- **To keep on: To continue doing sth.**

LET:

- **To let down: To lower. Dejar abandonado.**

LOOK:

- **To look after: To take care of.**
- **To look back: To consider the past; remember.**
- **To look for: To search for.**
- **To look forward to + V-ing: To anticipate (with pleasure)**
- **To look into: To investigate.**
- **To look out: Watch out !**

MAKE:

- **To make up: To invent, to put cosmetics on.**

PAY:

- **To pay back: To return money owed.**
- **To pay for: To receive punishment.**

PULL:

- **To pull down: To demolish.**

PUT:

- **To put across: To communicate successfully.**
- **To put in: To include.**
- **To put off: To postpone.**
- **To put on: To dress oneself in, to increase (in weight), to switch on,**
- **To put up with: To tolerate, bear.**

RUN:

- **To run away: To escape.**
- **To run out of: To no longer have a supply.**

STAND:

- **To stand by: To support sb esp in difficulties.**
- **To watch remaining inactive, to be ready for action.**

TAKE:

- **To take after: To look or act like a relative.**
- **To take off: To remove clothes (Opp: To put on), To leave the ground (planes) = Come down, To reduce weight (Opp: To put on).**

TURN:

- **To turn off: To switch off.**
- **To turn on: To switch on.**

WORK:

- **To work out: To find the solution to a problem by reasoning or calculation.**
